ABSTRACT

My outbound international mobility will aim at two main objectives:

- (i) Establish a collaborative network with national researchers from the region (Indonesia and Malaysia) to develop joint proposals on key regional NTFP species;
- (ii) initiate a research project on socio-economically important NTFP species through the supervision of an Indonesian PhD student, Jakty Kusuma a faculty member of Lampung State Polytechnic (LSP; Bandar Lampung, Indonesia). The PhD thesis focuses Indonesian nutmegs (*Myristica fragrans*, *M. fatua* and *M. argentea*). The species are cultivated for their seeds and maces, used as spices locally (all three species) or worldwide (*M. fragrans*). My mobility will allow meeting the student, defining his PhD objectives and conducting with him part of his sampling.
