The French-speaking Virology Days bring together more than 400 researchers, engineers, technicians, students, pharmacists, veterinarians, doctors and professors from a dozen French-speaking countries around the world. The themes addressed during this congress provide a global vision of the advances in the field of molecular and cellular, medical, veterinary and plant virology.

These days are organised by the French Society of Virology (<https://sfv-virologie.org/>). They have been held annually for over 20 years, usually at the Institut Pasteur in Paris.
